CAMPOREE RULES

GENERAL CAMPOREE RULES

- **All Units must have at least 2 adult leaders (SM, ASM, or other registered adult) present at all times at the camporee site. Each unit must have and turn in upon arrival a Local Tour Permit (These need to be filed with the Council 2 weeks before the event.)**
- Troops **must** check in at Camp Headquarters **before** selecting a campsite. Campsite selection is on a first come first served bases.
- The Troop Leaders are responsible for the conduct of their Scouts at all times.
- SAFETY - All travel and Camporee activities are to be conducted according to good safety standards. The Unit Leader will be aware of the safety of each member of his Troop at all times. Each Troop **must** have a suitable First Aid Kit in Camp at a **visible location**.
- Each Troop must provide proof of insurance as they check in. If the troop does not have insurance then they must pay, upon check in, an additional fee per boy for the weekend.
- **All** Scouts attending the Camporee must be currently registered with the Boy Scouts of America (Scouts, Explorers, etc.).
- GARBAGE - Each Troop must carry all unburnable garbage away upon leaving the Camporee. **DO NOT BURY GARBAGE OF ANY KIND.**
- Cutting of live trees is prohibited.
- Any Scouts who are running through or in any other Troop's campsite at any time or any Scouts found running around or making excessive noise after Taps may have points deducted from their Troop's Campsite Inspection score and may be asked to leave the Camporee.
- **Troops are responsible for the condition in which their campsite is left. No Troop will be allowed to check out until their site has been inspected by a member of camporee staff.**
