We Have a Three Track Program This Year:

Cub Scout Track

New Leader Essentials (NLE) - The basic training which gives the aims, methods, and objectives behind Boy Scout Training. Youth development, organization, finance, and policy are covered during this session. This session is for **ALL registered leaders in Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts**.

Cub Scout Leader Specific Training (CLS) - Each position in Scouting has specific training geared towards the age level of the youth involved. Pack organization, leadership, advancement, pack and den planning resources are explored in order to help the leader present the best program for their Scouts. Each new position provides and opportunity for additional training and fellowship in Scouting.

Boy Scout Track

Scoutmaster and Assistant Scoutmaster Leader Specific Training - Is a course for all troop leaders who have a supportive role within the troop. The goal of this training is to provide leaders with confidence, resources, and skills needed to carry out the Boy Scout program. The Ideals of scouting, the Patrol Method, the Outdoors, Advancement, Adult Association, Personal Growth, Leadership Development and the Uniform are the 8 methods discussed in this training.

Traditional Little Philmont Track

Every year an "LDS Week" (now two weeks) of advanced leadership training is conducted by the General Young Men's Presidency and General Authorities of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints (LDS) at BSA's Philmont Scout Ranch. Information from these training events is brought back to our local stakes and councils. The Traditional Little Philmont Track is composed of shortened classes based upon the information presented in the courses at the LDS Weeks at Philmont. The selected topics will provide training across all of the scouting programs and will be of benefit to all leaders of youth.

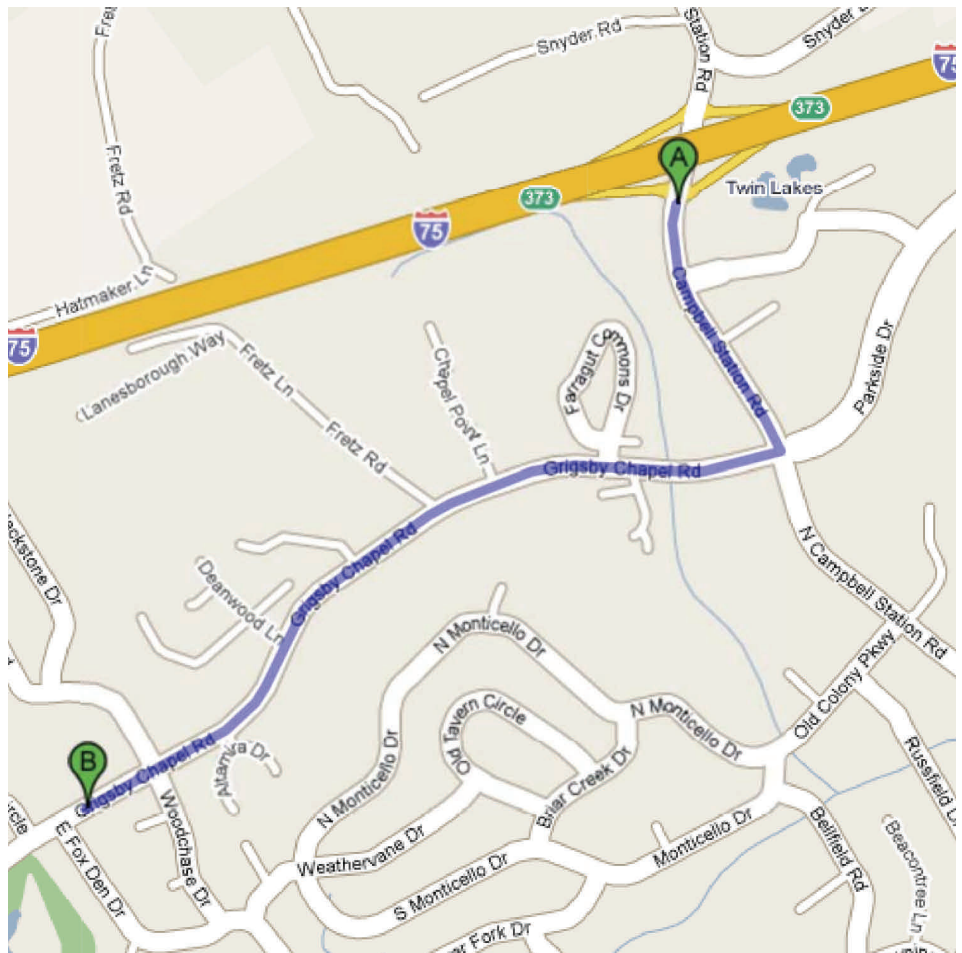
Knoxville Tennessee Stake Center
